Hospitality / industry

Go Short welcomes many filmmakers and professionals from the film world every year. As a hospitality & industry volunteer, you support the Hospitality & Industry-team in welcoming and guiding international guests. For example, you help with issues concerning festival passes and you answer questions from international guests at the Industry-desk. During other shifts you accompany filmmakers at dinners, drinks or other events. You mainly work at the Industry-desk where you help filmmakers find their way during Go Short and answer questions from international guests.

You:

- Can communicate clearly in English (other languages are an advantage)
- Are skilled with computers and database programs such as Excel, or you are a quick learner
- Are hospitable
- Are able to work under pressure

Working hours: during the festival, between 09:00 and 18:00.

Entrance coordinator

As an entrance coordinator, you are the face of the festival for the public. You welcome the public, scan tickets and refer people to the right hall. You guide the public flows in the right direction and communicate with the hall managers in LUX about the start and end of the program in the hall. You can be deployed by the location manager to where you are needed.

You:

- Have an open appearance
- Can communicate with the public in a professional manner
- Have problem-solving skills
- Are sociable

NOTE: In addition to the volunteer meeting prior to the festival, there is also a tour of LUX for hall managers, location managers and entrance coordinators. It is very useful if you can be there. Date to follow.

Working hours: during the festival, between 10:00 and 22:00.
